Wayne Goertel, 33 Park Lane: I am a member of the Budget Committee and a resident of Hooksett. I listened and watched the last School Board meeting and was interested in the Warrant articles presented. I support Adams initiative to create a sub-committee to work on the School Budget presentation. I would like to share some information which I put together. (Copies were distributed to the Board) There are two (2) copies. One is the Town Budget which we receive ahead of time along with the books. The Budget is broken down by department with actual and previous years budgets as well as Administrative cuts and Council's cuts. Their backup easy to follow and view. The challenge with the school budget was we were surprised to receive no books along with the excel file this year. The following meeting we met with the staff but the challenge was the accounts didn't match the books. I generated a new copy of the excel budget by school and account. I thought this would provide some background. The school board video I watch discussed the warrant articles. Due to the Revaluation in town, the tax burden has shifted to residential, the community will have a different focus on the budget than in past years.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

#### Warrant Articles\*

2. Shall the Hooksett School District vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$4,806,455 for the purpose of constructing and equipping an addition/renovation at the Fred C. Underhill School to address security, safety, and accessibility deficiencies; as well as the capacity to offer full day kindergarten and to authorize the issuance of not more than \$4,806,455 of bonds or notes under and in compliance with the provisions of the Municipal Finance Act (RSA33 et.seq., as amended); and to authorize the Hooksett School Board to apply for, accept and

expend federal, state or other aid, if any, which may be available for said project and to comply with all laws applicable to said project; and to authorize the Hooksett School Board to issue, negotiate, sell and deliver such bonds or notes and to determine the rate of interest thereon and the maturity and other terms thereof; and to authorize the Hooksett School Board to take any action or to pass any other vote relative thereto; and further to raise and addition sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_\_ for the first year's payment on the bond. (3/5 ballot vote required)

K. Lessard: We need to wait for the final budget numbers from the Budget Committee.

3. Shall the Hooksett School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purpose set fort therein, totaling <u>?</u> Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be <u>?</u>, which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Hooksett School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only.

K. Lessard: The bond requires a public hearing which must be held between January 11, 2019 and January 15, 2019.

## A public hearing will be held at the Cawley Middle School on Monday, January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 6:00 pm

4. Shall the Hooksett School District raise and appropriate the sum of \$95,500 to be added to the Construction and Equipment Capital Reserve Fund established in March of 1990? This sum to come from June 30, 2019 fund balance available for transfer on July 1, 2019. No amount to be raised from taxation. NOTE: This is the fourth payment of a four year plan to acquire the funds needed to replace the roof on the Fred C. Underhill School.

## **Draft Calendar**

Dr. Littlefield suggested that the School Board form a sub-committee to look at the school calendar. There was a Calendar Committee in place a few years ago which made recommendations and reviewed the day vs hourly calendar. Dr. Littlefield will add it to the list of committee to be assigned by the Board next year.

# G. Martakos motioned to table the Draft Calendar. Seconded by J. Sullivan. Vote unanimously in favor.
