March 11, 2025 Election Results

Thank you for coming out to Cawley Middle School to make your choices for the town and school warrant articles. Here is a summary of the results for the School District ballot (in italics).

1. School District Officers
 - a. School Board Members
 - i. Bob Barker and John Ciempa were elected for three-year terms.*
 - ii. Michael Dullen was elected for a two-year term*
 - b. School District Treasurer
 - i. Amy Boilard was elected for a one-year term*
2. School Facilities Project
 - a. \$5,995,998 for Hooksett Memorial School
 - b. The bond required a 60% vote, and was **not** approved by voters: 1,010 yes to 1,024 no*
3. School District Operating Budget
 - a. Proposed budget: \$44,850,349
 - b. Default budget: \$43,959,116
 - c. The proposed budget was **not** approved by voters: 744 yes to 1,289 no*
4. Special Education Expendable Trust Fund contribution
 - a. \$150,000 from fund balance
 - b. The warrant was approved by voters: 1,214 yes to 883 no*
5. Building Maintenance Expendable Trust Fund contribution
 - a. \$100,000 from taxation
 - b. The warrant was **not** approved by voters: 1,029 yes to 1,066 no*
6. Technology Expendable Trust Fund contribution
 - a. \$50,000 from additional taxation
 - b. The warrant was **not** approved by voters: 891 yes to 1,193 no*
7. Curriculum Capital Reserve Fund
 - a. \$100,000 from fund balance
 - b. The warrant was approved by voters: 1,176 yes to 919 no*
8. Replacement Furniture/Equipment
 - a. \$58,005 from additional taxation
 - b. The warrant was **not** approved by voters: 903 yes to 1,191 no*

The need for facilities improvements at Hooksett Memorial School remains outstanding, despite the lack of voter support for the project offered on the March ballot. The Hooksett School District Facilities Subcommittee will hold a public meeting on Monday, April 14th at 4:30 PM in the David R. Cawley Middle School Media Center.
