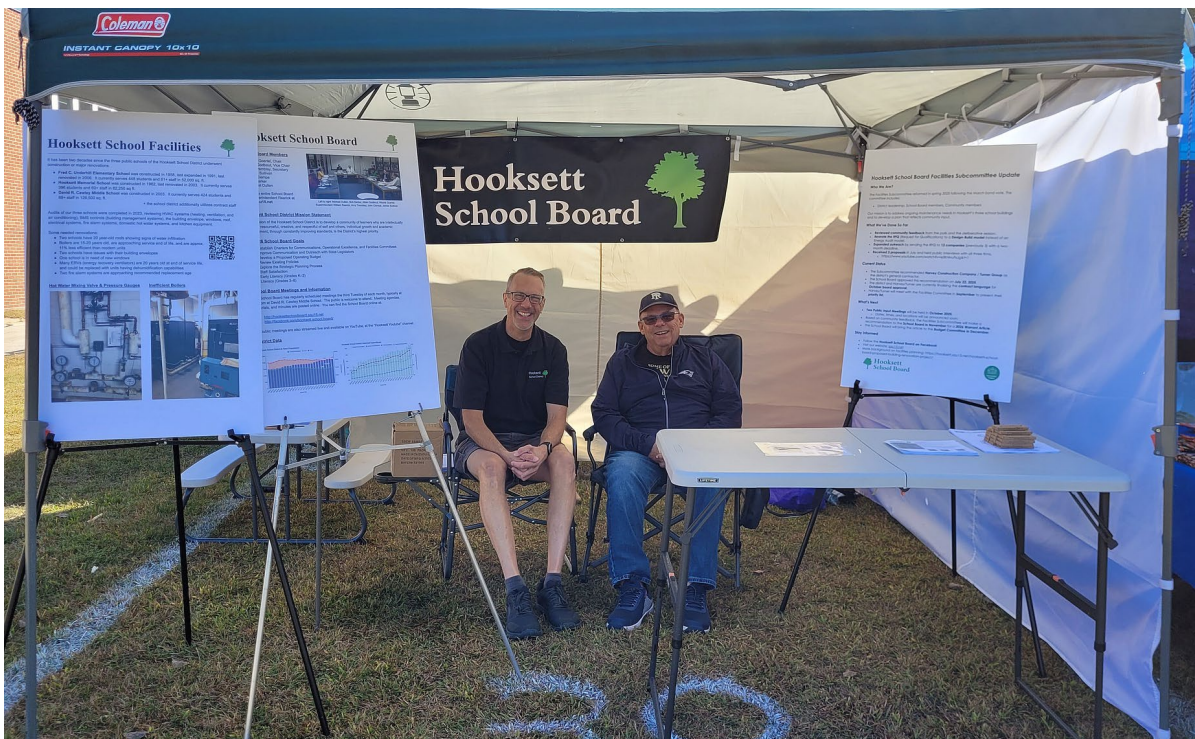




Hooksett School Board at Old Home Day
